THE GUYS

Theatre play inspired by the true story of how Elvis Presley nearly quit showbusiness in the mid 60's to become a monk. Explored through his entourage - The King never appears in the play – he's always in the other room. Commissioned and read publicly at the Bush Theatre. First under Mike Bradwell, then Josie Rourke. Currently being developed with producer Caroline Dyott and current Donmar associate director Rob Hastie for a future production in London.

THE LONDON GANDHI

Play. 1889. Vain, self obsessed, super-earnest 19 year old Mohandas Gandhi studies Law in England. Extraordinarily, the fire that would inspire the dismantling of the Empire, was kindled in London. Funded by Arts Council England and Peggy Ramsay Foundation. Developed with Director, Toby Frow. Reading at R.A.D.A in December 2012 with Kevin McNally, Claire Louise Cordwell and Susan Engel.

MARTHA LOVES MICHAEL

Theatre play about an obsessive Michael Jackson fan surviving on faith of his innocence against the background of his infamous sex abuse case. Co-written with Sally Abbott and produced by our company Ruffian Productions in partnership with The Junction, Cambridge. Fully funded by Arts Council East, East to Edinburgh and Escalator. It had a four week run at the Pleasance Theatre, Edinburgh and toured East England.

INSTANT KARMA.

Devised play about a loser with revolutionary delusions who finds John Lennon living in his closet. Co-written with Sally Abbott. Play reading at Manchester Met with George Costigan, Jeff Hordley, Zoe Henry and Martin Hancock.

TRIPPING THE COLOUR

Devised play. Co-written with Sally Abbott. Culminated in a reading.
