

# Myles McLeod . Curriculum Vitae

Myles McLeod is one half of BAFTA winning *The Brothers McLeod*. Myles holds a Masters in Screenwriting, and has written for TV, books, magazines, short film and computer games. He has over one hundred broadcast credits. In 2013 Myles was one of 27 finalists for the BBC Writersroom script room. His half-hour live action drama was selected from 2800 submissions and was subsequently developed for CBBC Drama. His short film *Marfa* premiered at the 2018 Sundance Film Festival and was nominated for a BAFTA Film Award. His co-written short *The Witch and the Baby* has won multiple festival awards. In 2021 Myles was head writer for *Circle Square (Milkshake!)* and *Millie and Lou (Blue Zoo Animations for YouTube Originals)*. His Knight Sir Louis book series includes four titles, with a fifth due out in 2023.
